
The Chairperson of USOL is requested to take action as per the following resolutions made in the Co-ordination Committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor/ Syndicate held on 05/08/2020 and 10.08.2020 to deliberate upon the issues of examination/assessment, evaluation, and grades to students, Entrance Tests and online teaching process for the session 2020-2021:

REGARDING PROMOTION OF STUDENTS, EXAMINATIONS AND ADMISSIONS of USOL:

In the previous meeting it was decided that USOL would frame and submit guidelines regarding promotion of students and conducting online Personal Contact Programme (PCP) for the academic session 2020-2021. Consequently, Chairperson, USOL submitted the following guidelines which were unanimously **approved by the Committee:**

- a. Admission process will be as per UGC (DEB) guidelines- it will be started from August 5, 2020 till October 2020. PCP schedule has been made to conduct offline/online classes with effect from 5th October, 2020 till 1st December, 2020 (depending on the circumstances)
- b. Students of Post graduate courses in 2nd Semester will be promoted on the basis of 50% Internal Assessment and 50% marks obtained in previous semester marks as done for other departments of P.U.
- c. Students of ongoing classes (with Compartment/Re-appear) shall be promoted provisionally so that admission to the next semester is carried out and results will be declared as per University decision.
- d. Decision on Entrance Test for MBA will be taken up when University takes decision with regard to Entrance Test of P.G. courses offered by Panjab University.

- e. Decision with regard to Final semester students of P.G. Diplomas, Certificate Courses and Undergraduate and Post Graduate classes will be taken as and when University decides.
- f. For intermediate classes of undergraduate courses, students will be promoted on the basis of marks obtained in the previous semesters (As no internal assessment is available for distance education students).
