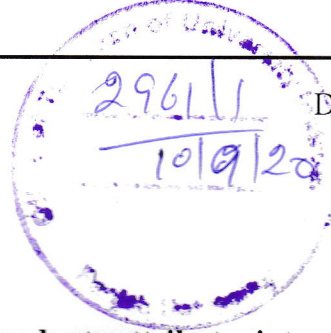

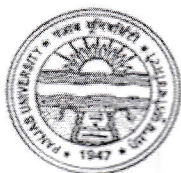

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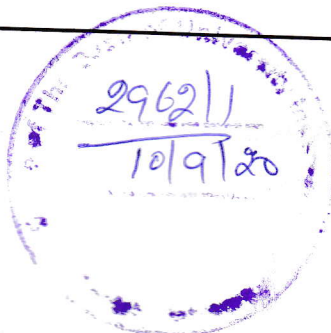

Sub: Mandate to maintain outgoing student's records at the department level (requirements of NAAC)

Resp. Sir,

As per the requirement of NAAC (Criterion 5.2.1, 5.2.2, 5.2.3), all the departments are mandated to keep a record of their outgoing students year wise (from 2015 onward) under the following headings

1. Students qualifying in state/ national/ international level examinations (e.g.: NET/SLET/GATE/GMAT/CAT/GRE/TOEFL/Civil Services/State government examinations) and the qualifying certificate of the outgoing students year wise (the last 5 years).
2. Maintain a record of the placement of outgoing students along with the placement details such as the name of the company, compensation, etc. year wise. In addition, there is a need to clarify to the departments that the placement record is not limited to the placements on campus but also the placements off campus by the students themselves and self-employment. Departments giving placement levels of anything less than 100 percent means that their students are unemployed.
3. The departments are also required to maintain a record of the graduated students who have progressed to higher education and supporting documents such as admission letters or identity cards for selected students progressing to higher education.
4. Record of economic weaker students should be maintained at department level.

The same data has been asked from the departments repeatedly at our end. However, turn in of the data has been very poor. Therefore, you are requested to direct the department to ensure the maintenance of these records and turn in these records to IQAC in time as and when asked. It is pertinent to mention here that in ranking like NIRF, P.U. has scored very badly on account of these two criteria.
