Subject: Celebration of India's 75 years of Independence – India@75

This is to inform that the celebration of 75 years of India's Independence – "Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav" would commence 75 weeks prior to the Independence Day 2022 and will extend upto Independence Day 2023. The launch of the celebration will be a 25 day event starting on 12.3.2021 (anniversary of the launch of Dandi March) and conclude on 5th April 2021 (conclusion of Dandi March).

- 2. The Hon'ble Prime Minister will launch the opening ceremony on the 12th of March from Gujarat. For the inauguration, several events have been planned, including the following:-
 - (i) 75 places of historical significance (2 or 3 per State/UT) to be decided by the States for celebration of the event (Chief Secretaries of all States/UTs)
 - (ii) In these 75 places of historical significance, participation by Youth Clubs, NYK, NSS/NSO/NCC volunteers (Department of Youth Affairs)
 - (iii) Organization of Cycle Rallies at different places (Department of Youth Affairs)
 - (iv) 1 hour Conference/Seminar/Symposium by Schools, Colleges and Universities on India's freedom struggle on 12th March, 2021 (Department of School Education & Literacy and UGC).
 - (v) Launch of Essay Competition at School/Tehsil/District/State/ National levels (Department of School Education & Literacy)
 - (vi) Launch of Essay Competition for Universities & Colleges (UGC/AICTE)
 - (vii) Exhibitions to be organised by the State Governments in coordination with BOC-
 - (a) Exhibitions on Mahatma Gandhi, Sardar Patel & Netaji to be organised by BOC at various locations (Ministry of I&B) and



- (b) Exhibitions on freedom fighters and unsung heroes to be organised by the State Governments (Chief Secretaries of all States/UTs)
- 3. For effective dissemination and communication of all the events and for coordination with the State Governments, the following Action Plan has been decided upon involving various Media Units:-

(i) Press Information Bureau:

- a) PIB would coordinate with State DIPR for publicity/events
- b) Press releases including in local languages of the 12th March event and of subsequent dates
- c) Tweeting and retweeting the various events which are organised at the national level and the regional levels including Social Media posts/tweets of Hon'ble PM, Union Ministers, Hon'ble Governors, Chief Ministers, other Ministers and dignitaries
- d) Facilitating the publication of Articles in local language by State dignitaries or eminent historians/academics/defence personnel

(ii) Doordarshan and AIR

- a) Live coverage of the events by DD and AIR including bites/clips in news bulletins, special programmes and primetime discussion on India@75, including a national capsule of all India events in the evening of 12th March, 2021.
- b) DD/AIR to also cover the various events organised by the State Governments on the occasion.

(iii) Social Media

- a) Social Media campaign by the New Media Wing, PIB, DD News and AIR NSD including live streaming of the events, short clips/bites of the guests at the launch, dedicated Hashtags and Infographics and Tweets by influencers
- 4. It is requested that necessary action on the above is taken on priority.
