NCRB invites original and previously unpublished research papers / articles on Police related topics including Law, Scientific Investigation, Criminology, Forensic Science, Finger Print Science, Physical, Biological and behavioural measurements, Contemporary Legal issues, Cybercrime, investigation, Cyber security for Volume 2 Issue 1 of NCRB Journal. Any good research or practical methodology that is relevant to the efficiency need of the police service is welcome. The journal also encourages articles written by a scholarly pair with a police officer on a relevant topic.

The manuscript should be typed in 12 point, double spaced with at least inch margin MS-Word. The manuscript normally should not exceed 5,000 words. However, lengthy articles may also be considered for publication in case the editorial board decides so. The manuscript should include an abstract of approximately 150 words and 4-5 keywords. All photos, images and illustrations should be of high quality with 300 dpi or higher resolution and must be saved as separate files in JPG, PNG or TIF format. The Charts, diagrams and sketches should be drawn accurately and clearly. If a chart has supporting data, it should be given in Excel format. The Caption should accurately describe what is represented in the graphic / image. For manuscript in Hindi, please use Unicode font (Mangal). The manuscripts are subject to review and editing. All manuscripts accepted for publication shall be property of NCRB Journal. No article or part of it shall be reproduced or used by author without permission. A brief biographical sketch of each author, describing his or her

expertise in the subject area including name, title, affiliation and contact information with phone number and email address will be required.
